

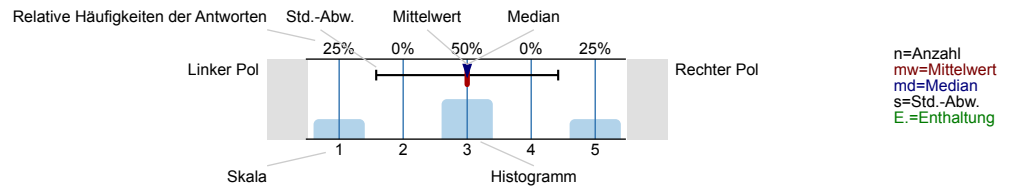

2. Apart from your university studies, how many hours per week on average do you work during the semester?

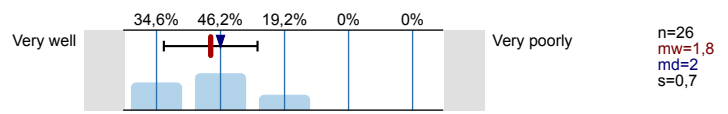

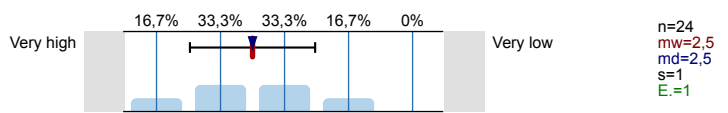

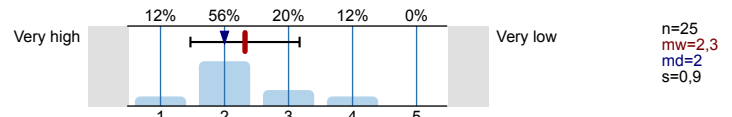

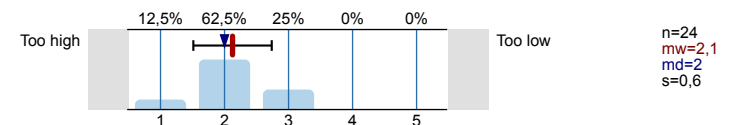

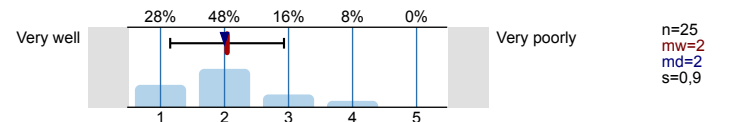

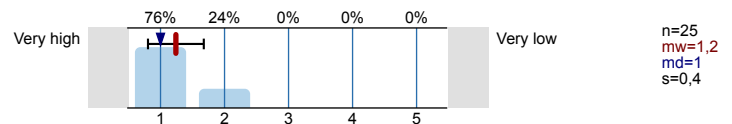

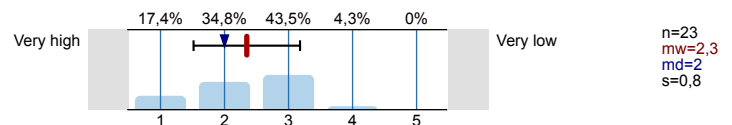

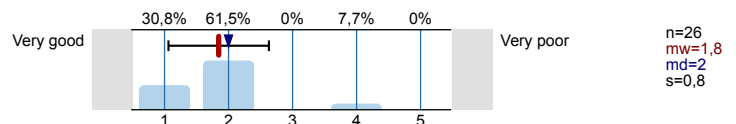

3. Which aspects of this course should be changed so that future students can profit more from it?

It's more about the timing, in my opinion it is hard ~~to~~ work on a subject as complex as psychoanalysis for 4 hours straight.

The text are too long and too strange. I didn't read all of them because I haven't got time for everything.

- I didn't like the presentations at all, as we aren't specialists of the subject it wasn't always easy ~~and~~ to understand what they meant.

A lot of the material ~~at the~~ from the reader is at a very high level and might be ~~to~~ too challenging for non-native english speakers

- develop clear concepts of the psychoanalytic theories

not so much of the course based on student's presentation which are sometimes rather poor. → a presentation of the teacher on each subject would be nice.

Providing more precise definitions of the psychoanalytic terms and notions -

- explanation of all concepts by the professor in class (not just via student presentations).

All class lectures (slides) could be made available to students.

some texts were too complex. a resume or a simpler version would be sometimes more helpful.

There were a lot of readings, and some were quite dense. Maybe eliminating some to focus on the most important.

Shorter text. A lot of material to grasp. Sometimes 80+ a week.
Dense text, good material though

- ~~more~~ watch note, not longer films clips. Allow us to analyze film instead of being lectured at.
- more discussion
- texts in the reader are too long and hard to understand
→ reader is not read by most students
better use shorter texts
- make summary of each lectures outcome available
- more discussion
- Better slides/presentation, there weren't many definitions, text in general. Not very helpful slides for exam preparation

- easier readings
- teacher's slides
- more active participation of students (e.g. group work)

The level of difficulties for the text should go down a bit.
